Position Summary

The Site Coordinator will be the main point of contact for coaches, players, and families on game days in the Sporting Recreation League and Sporting Adult Soccer League. The Site Coordinator will be expected to assist in: league operations, field management, referee assignment, and customer service.

Sporting Rec League

The Sporting Rec League (SRL) is a recreational soccer league organized and ran by Major League Soccer club Sporting Kansas City, catering to participants from Pre-K to 4th Grade.

There are four separate SRL locations: Compass Minerals Sporting Fields in Kansas City, Kansas, Garmin Olathe Soccer Complex in Olathe, Kansas, Central Bank Sporting Complex in Kansas City, MO (Northland), and Homefield-Olathe in Olathe, Kansas.

Sporting Adult Soccer League

The Sporting Adult Soccer League (SASL) is an adult soccer league organized and ran by Major League Soccer club Sporting Kansas City. SASL provides three league options: Men's Open, Over 30, and CoEd.

SASL takes place at Compass Minerals Sporting Fields in Kansas City, KS and Central Bank Sporting Complex in Kansas City, MO (Northland).

Essential Functions

- Field set-up and clean-up
- Confirm all fields have referees
- Customer Service: answer questions, help families find the proper field, etc.





- Communicate with coaches and referees to confirm games kick off at proper time
- Ensure all coaches and parents are following the Sporting Rec League Codes of Conduct

- Strong organizational, communications and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to organize work effectively, conceptualize and prioritize objectives and exercise independent judgment based on an understanding of organizational policies and activities.
